

Top Rating of Tripura State Pollution Control Board in Public Disclosure of Information in North East India

In a report published by the Centre for Science & Environment, New Delhi performances of all the State Pollution Control Boards/ Pollution Control Committees in the country were rated based on public disclosure of information of various regulatory activities under the Water Act 1974 and Air Act 1981. Thirty one Boards/Committees were evaluated based on essential information disclosed in their websites.

The Tripura State Pollution Control Board ranked 17th position and this was higher than all other Boards in North East India. Meghalaya, Assam, Sikkim, Mizoram, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh and Manipur State Pollution Control Boards ranked 18, 19, 20, 21, 26, 28 and 29 positions, respectively (www.Cseindia.org).
